Neighborhood Assistance Program

What is NAP?

The Neighborhood Assistance Program (NAP) encourages individuals, trusts, or businesses to donate to approved non-profit organizations benefitting low-income persons. Donors receive a tax credit equal to 65% of the donation applied against Virginia personal income taxes as well as a federal deduction for charitable contributions. Donations can be cash or marketable securities given directly to NAP-approved 501(c)(3) organizations, such as TAP.

How does it help?

TAP is a NAP-approved organization through the Department of Education. Donations support TAP's general fund, allowing the agency to do things like: supply work boots to teenagers in job-training programs, patch roofs for elderly homeowners, help homeless vets find jobs and housing, provide infants and toddlers with high-quality early childhood education, and much more!

How does the tax credit work?

Donor	Minimum donation*	Maximum donation*	VA tax credit
Individual	\$500	\$125,000	65%
Trust	\$616	none	65%
Business	\$616	none	65%

*Excess credit may be carried forward to next five years

How do I contribute?

To receive tax credits for a donation, contact TAP to determine if it has any remaining tax credits to allocate. If tax credits are still available, TAP will send you a Contribution Notification Form. You must return the completed form to receive allocated tax credits. TAP then coordinates the transfer of the tax credits; once complete, you will receive a tax credit certificate to affix to your next tax return.
